- Provides police agencies with a practical way to verify and enforce Civil Protection Orders.
- Is a convenient method for domestic violence victims to provide evidence of a Civil Protection Order.
- Contains vital Civil Protection Order information including the name, identifying characteristics of the person ordered to stay away, names of protected people, and dates of issuance and expiration.
- There is NO fee for the Civil Protection Order or the wallet card.
- Any person with a Civil Protection Order granted after a full hearing is entitled to a wallet card.
