A former Judge of the Stow Municipal Court. She was appointed by Gov. DeWine in June 2025 to complete an unexpired term which ended on December 31, 2025. While on the bench, Curtin handled a docket of approximately 500 cases per month, overseeing misdemeanor crimes, traffic offenses, and civil cases valued under \$15,000.

Her pre-judicial career involved over 35 years of extensive litigation experience handling matters involving personal injury, products liability, premises liability, employment, worker's comp, insurance coverage, contracts, and probate. She practiced throughout Ohio state courts and federal courts. Her practice involved jury trials, appellate argument, motion practice, settlement negotiation, mediation, and arbitration. She represented individuals, small businesses, large corporations, national retailers and national insurers. She also worked with national coordinating counsel on cases nationwide in various state and federal courts.

Curtin's legal experience began at the litigation law firm of Keller, Scully & Williams in Cleveland. In 2003, she and her late husband, G. Michael Curtin, founded their own litigation law firm, Curtin & Associates, in Akron. The firm was renamed to Curtin & Curtin, and later, Curtin Law. Under Curtin's leadership, the firm became a certified woman-owned law firm. In 2023, Curtin closed the law firm and joined Perez-Morris in Cleveland, a woman owned law firm headquartered in Columbus with offices in Cleveland, Toledo, Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania.

Curtin is a graduate of Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana, where she received a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. She received her law degree from the CSU Cleveland - Marshall College of Law.
